CHAMONIX - MEET A FAMOUS CHEF WHILE DISCOVERING THE TOWN - A CLASSIC!

The famous CHEF MICKEY BOURDILLAT welcomes you into his kitchen at the 5-star Hotel Mont-Blanc while he prepares the lunch menu. We then make an off-the-beaten path discovery of secret Chamonix for contrasting perspectives. A unique and exclusive experience, already a Photo Walk classic. The lunch menu is an additional 22 €, plus beverages.

TRÉLECHAMPS - A PRESERVED ENVIRONMENT IN A STORY-BOOK SETTING

As if suspended in time... Simply a magical experience on this protected plateau of forest, snow fields and traditional chalets. Wonderful photographs to be taken in all weather conditions, especially if it snows during the walk. The experience will be even more remarkable if you arrive at Montroc on the little red train.

VALLORCINE - ENJOY SEEING YOUR PHOTOS EXHIBITED DURING THE 2016 PHOTO EXPO

Pride of place could be the motto for the locals of Vallorcine, a mountain village at the tip of the valley with unique Walser architecture, black cows, and a traditional café. YOUR images, taken during this walk, will be on display for the upcoming FOUR SEASONS OF VALLORCINE photo exhibit in 2016. This is an especially nice opportunity for the up-and-coming young generation of photographers to show-off their talent.

COUPEAU - ISOLATED HAMLETS NESTLED IN A NATURAL SETTING & WHAT A VIEW!!

Perhaps the most impressive perspective of the Mont Blanc range is found in this natural setting. We will climb, by car, to the top of Coupeau where traditional alpine huts benefit from extraordinary sun and a rare sense of space. Dry road and good path conditions are necessary in order to do this walk.

SERVOZ - AUTHENTIC RURAL VILLAGE, OLD FARMS, STONE FOUNTAINS, COWS & TRADITIONS

Servoz is always an unexpected surprise for those curious enough to venture into this rural village where architecture, traditional life-style, red cows and dynamic chefs make Servoz a hidden treasure to visit.
